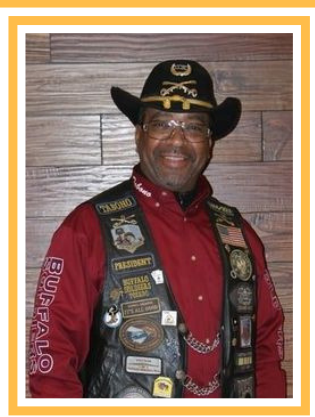

A Vietnam Veteran, serving as a Combat Medic 1970 – 1971; currently hold a commission with the Lucas County Sheriff's Office and Security Director for Key Hotels and Property Management. I ride a 2012 Ultra Classic Limited Harley Davidson and 1985 1200 Goldwing, riding since 1972.

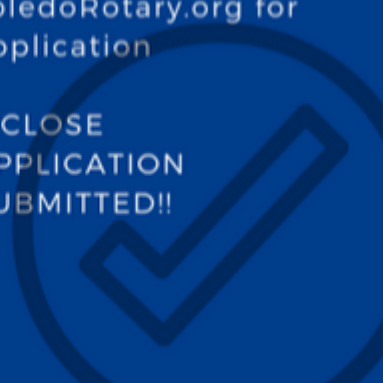
