## Signs of the Times

The first of the new entrance signs has been installed at the Wildwood main entrance. The second is in progress at Pearson. New secondary entrance signs are also being installed.

## Old Mill Getting New Paint

The Board this morning approved a contract with Eco Painting for the final phase of a renovation at the Ludwig Mill, which will include painting the exterior and metal roof.

The first phase, completed last year, focused on the foundation and structure. The second phase, this spring, involved replacing timber framing, windows and the accessible ramp at the entrance.

## Marina District Moves Forward

Toledo City Council yesterday voted 12-0 to sell the downtown waterfront property known as the Marina District to ProMedica, which plans to sell all or a portion of the land to Metroparks.

## Railroad Crossing to Come Down

The Wood County Port Authority will demolish the former Toledo Terminal Railroad's Upriver Bridge over the Maumee River after determining the 114-year-old span is not able to be renovated for use as a bicycle trail. The bridge is part of the railroad corridor purchased by several partners, including Metroparks, for the Chessie Circle Trail. [[Story](#)]
