Dr. Tyrone Bledsoe is an educator with more than 33 years of high quality post secondary education experience. He is the founder and current CEO-President of the Student African American Brotherhood (SAAB) Organization----a national organization with over 355 chapters in 41 states that endeavors to instill a "spirit of care" in, and enhance the experiences of African American and Latino males in our country. Before transitioning to his role with SAAB, Dr. Bledsoe served as Vice President for Student Life and Special Assistant to the President at the University of Toledo.

Student African American Brotherhood (SAAB), founded in 1990, has chapters on more than 200 Middle and High School/College and University campuses in 39+ states across the country. SAAB operates through student chapters where young men of color enjoy social, cultural and spiritual enrichment. SAAB increases the number of young men graduating from college by creating a positive peer community based on a spirit of caring.







Matt Bell is 32 year old Toledo native who graduated from St. Francis de Sales in 2005 and earned an academic/athletic scholarship to the University of Toledo, where he played baseball. After an injury he became addicted to the pain killers that were prescribed to him, and one thing lead to another, ending in a 9 year bout with heroin. Jails, arrests, and overdoses became his reality, although they was never anything he foresaw or dreamt of doing.

Today, Matt serves as the President and cofounder of Team Recovery (his non profit organization), & the C.E.O. & the co-founder of Midwest Detox Center, Midwest Recovery Center, Ohio Detox Center, & Ohio Treatment Center. He is also the C.O.O. of the midwest region of his national behavioral health agency, Amatus Health. He uses his past & his biggest liabilities as assets to help the individuals and families who are still suffering from the disease of addiction, and to carry an important message to our youth.

Matt has an 8 year old son who attends St. Rose in Perrysburg, will hopefully be engaged soon if all goes well, and lives in Sylvania township.


