

The Ability Center of Greater Toledo operates a facility to train dogs and participants in both Assistance Dogs for **Achieving Independence (ADAI) and Agility Angels** programming. ADAI currently has 117 dogs working to better the live of individuals with disabilities, and 68 dogs in some level of training. Some dogs provide assistance with physical tasks while others are trained to provide comfort for individuals with autism. Agility Angels serves individuals with various degrees of autism and teaches them to work with assistance dogs.
