Monday, June 28th Recap

On Monday, Jon talked about the impact of upcoming 5G everywhere, the newly changed consumer behavior thanks to COVID-19, and the looming generational shift thanks to Generation Z, that will make the commerce in the 2020s look more like the 1920s than the 21st century. Thanks to the internet that is ubiquitous, cheap, and available everywhere, people will no longer "go shopping", but rather will always be shopping.

Jon Reily is a 25-year Commerce veteran who founded and sold two successful companies in the first dotcom boom of the 1990s. He then continued a successful career advising and guiding companies from start-ups to global brand powerhouses to design their digital futures over the last two decades

Before joining dentsu, Reily was Head of Global Commerce Strategy at Publicis Sapient, where he advised Fortune 500 companies how to transform themselves digitally to stay competitive in the increasingly technology focused world of digital commerce.

Previous to joining Publicis Sapient, Reily was a senior leader at Amazon.com where he re-invented how Amazon sells and marketed their 1st-party manufactured devices, such as Amazon Alexa, the Kindle Fire and FireTV, and helped create a multi-billion-dollar business division within Amazon.

Reily is a strong advocate of the importance of the experience in any digital strategy and that companies who embody this will thrive, and those who do not will not. As a result, he has been a driving force in the global commerce space for nearly a decade. A successful strategist, futurist, and forecaster of future trends, Reily is a major factor in dentsu commerce's toolkit to help its clients on their digital journeys.
