Dr. Rekha Chaudhary, M.D. Hematology/Oncology

Rekha Chaudhary, MD, has been a medical oncologist for the University of Cincinnati Neuroscience Institute since 2010 and is an associate professor of medicine in the Department of Hematology/Oncology and the department of Neurology at the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine. She is also an affiliated faculty with the UC Center for Integrative Health and Wellness. Before her time at UC she was an assistant professor of medicine in the Department of Hematology/Oncology and an Internal Medicine Residency associate program director t the University of Toledo Medical Center.

Dr. Chaudhary's interest is in integrating conventional medicine with other world philosophies and thoughts, specifically diet modification and its effect on tumor growth.
