While he was a member of the Grand Rapids Presbyterian Church he planned and led canoe trips to Ohio and Michigan rivers. Week long camping and canoeing trips were held on the Maumee, Mohican and Little Miami Rivers in Ohio. Similar trips were held on the Au Sable, Manistee, Pierre Marquette, Rifle, Pine River in Michigan. Family trips also included canoeing on the Huron, Pigeon, Jordan, Betsie, Platt, Boardman, Little Manistee, Sturgeon, and Manistique Rivers in Michigan.

Randy is a member of the Fist Presbyterian Church of Waterville. Randy is a multiple Paul Harris Fellow and a member of the Paul Harris Society. Randy has completed his eleventh complete MESA Bike Tour in June, passing the 3000-mile mark for MESA. Randy has served as M.E.S.A. Bike Tour Chairman since 2016.

Randy and his wife, Gloria reside in rural Grand Rapids, Ohio. They have three grown children and four grandchildren. When Randy is not volunteering, he helps his son Neil on the farm. His hobbies include biking, canoeing, and collecting Lionel trains.




