What's On Tom Walton's Mind?

Rotarian Tom Walton shares his unique take on the world around us, especially as reflected in his humor commentary column in the Sunday Blade.

Thomas Walton is the retired Editor and Vice President of the Toledo Blade. He retired in 2007 after a 42-year career in the newspaper business, all of it with Block Communications, Inc.

He joined the company after his graduation from Bowling Green State University in 1965. He began his career as a Blade State Desk reporter, moving to the City Desk in 1967. He was named chief of The Blade's Columbus Bureau in 1972, and in 1975 he moved to Monterey, California, to become Editor of The Monterey Peninsula Herald, at the time a Block-owned newspaper.

He returned to Toledo to become Editor of The Blade in 1988. He was named Vice President of The Blade in 1996.

While in California his editorials were cited twice by the California Newspaper Publishers Association as the best in the state. Several years later his Blade editorials on the Coingate scandal won an Inland Press Association first-place award and were nominated for a Pulitzer Prize.

Since retiring, Mr. Walton has written a humor commentary column on The Blade's Pages of Opinion.
