Elevated Lead Levels in Children and Adolescents

Dr. Marilynne Wood, pediatric educator, clinician, researcher and community activist, will speak of her experience over the past 10 years in screening and educating hundreds of families of how lead poisoning is effecting their children with elevated lead levels.

Dr. Wood has collaborated with city government to pass a lead ordinance to assure "lead safe" housing for young families in the Toledo area. She has worked extensively with University of Toledo College of Nursing graduate students to identify children with lead poisoning and to help parents make their homes leadsafe.

The Rotary Club of Toledo has had a vested interest in Lead Levels locally, as it was previously one of our Transformational Projects. 
