The New Energy Economy - Opportunities and Challenges

JoAnn Chávez is the DTE Energy senior vice president and chief legal officer and has overall responsibility for the Office of the General Counsel, Ethics & Compliance and Corporate Security.

Chávez is a strong advocate for young people. She recently founded the Michigan Hispanic Collaborative, a Michigan non-profit, that focuses on economic equity and provides opportunities for first-generation Hispanic students, like herself, to graduate from college. The organization delivers culturally relevant programming for both students and parents to help bring coherence to the chaos of college access.

Chávez also sits on the Cristo Rey Network and the United States Hispanic Leadership Institute boards of directors; she is the past chairwoman of the Michigan Hispanic Chamber of Commerce board of directors; and was recently appointed by Governor Gretchen Whitmer to the State of Michigan Women's Commission.

JoAnn Chávez will present an overview of the road to net zero, opportunities provided by the Inflation Reduction Act, and the respective to challenges to accelerate progress.
