



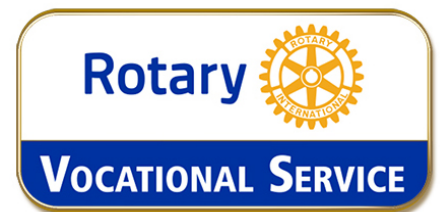

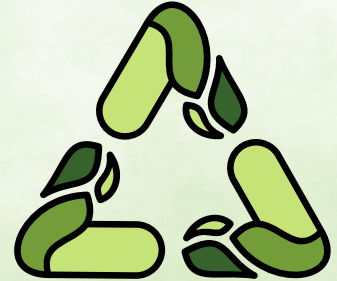
BECOME A GREEN SPONSOR!
