The James Webb Space Telescope: A New Window Into Our Origins

The launch of the James Webb Space Telescope (JWST) on Christmas Day 2021 opened a new and exciting window into our Universe.

Its 20 foot-diameter mirror and suite of instruments is allowing astronomers to study every phase of the history of the Universe ranging from the first galaxies to form after the Big Bang to the formation of solar systems like our own.

In this talk, Dr. Cushing will describe what makes JWST so unique and present some of its early findings including discoveries made by astronomers at the University of Toledo.
