Toledo Tomorrow and Local Education Support

Toledo Tomorrow started as Toledo's College and Career Access group for high school students in the city. Since it began over 5 years ago, a couple of its partners asked it to extend the career tech work into Workforce, to help more adults in Lucas County find skilled training and jobs, and to help our regional employers attract more employees. After a number of years working in partnership with the State of Ohio, Toledo Tomorrow was invited to form a Regional Education Partnership for Northwest Ohio, similar to those that exist in other cities in the State.

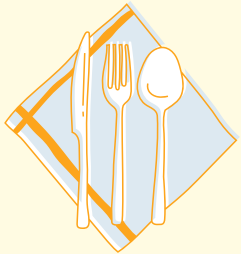
