Partners in Education - an Update

Brooke was born and raised in Toledo. She graduated from Central Catholic high school and Ohio University. After graduation, she moved to Chicago and then New York, working in Human Resources before completing her Master of Science in Teaching at Fordham University.

Brooke and her husband Erik then moved overseas to Warsaw, Poland where they worked at the American School of Warsaw, an embassy/International school, for four years. After the birth of their sons, Colin and Caleb, they moved back to Toledo to be near family.

Once back in Toledo, Brooke worked at Maumee Valley Country Day for ten years before leaving to work as an educational consultant, developing curriculum and training for various projects while working on her PhD in Curriculum and Instruction with a focus on literacy at the University of Toledo. She currently serves as the Executive Director of Partners in Education.

Brooke will be speaking about the mission and work of Partners in Education, a Rotary-founded nonprofit with a focus on K-12 literacy and college/career readiness. Her presentation will include PIE's history, current programming, community needs, and information about how you can get involved and be a "partner in education" for students in the Toledo community.

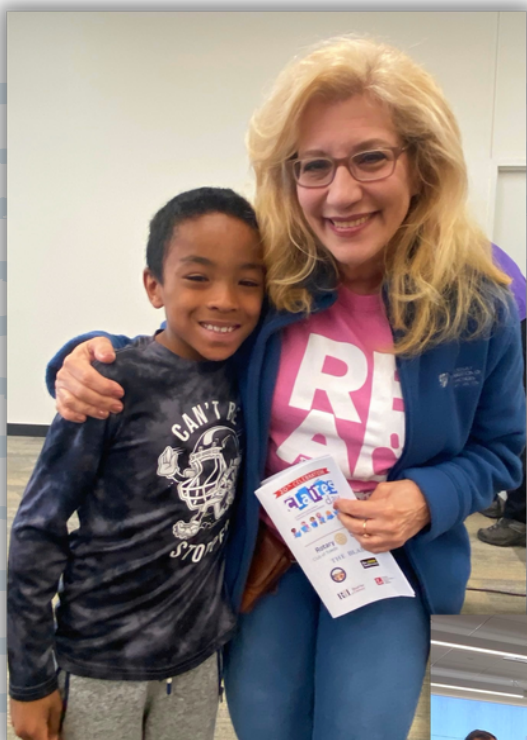
