Transformational Projects Panel Discussion

Join us on Monday, as we will be reviewing the current status of our three Transformational Projects and working to establish a plan for the future. Toledo Rotary has always prided itself on making a significant, long-term, positive impact, and these projects will do just that.

 $Our\ current\ Transformational\ Projects,\ as\ voted\ by\ the\ club\ in\ 2018,\ are\ the\ following:$

- 1. **Universal Pre-Kindergarten Education**. This project was established to work with local government, businesses and organizations to advocate for universal pre-kindergarten education in our community.
- 2.Lead Poisoning Identification, Education, and Abatement. This project was established to work with local government, businesses and organizations to form a coalition to advocate for the remediation and elimination of harmful lead exposure in homes and apartments in Toledo.
- 3. *Water Advocacy*. This project was established to contribute to Clean Water in our Lake Erie watershed including any tributaries leading into the Lake.




Membership Votes to Approve Dues Increase

The increase over current rates will be: \$25 increase for Under 40 members \$50 increase for over 40 members

(No rate change for Corporate Members, and the new member entry fees remain the same)



\$300 annually for Under 40 members \$600 annually for Over 40 members

- 3. Third place and the winner of the \$200 award is Gracyn Felix, a freshman at Wauseon High School. Gracyn chose the theme Justice. The title of the speech was The Reality of Inequity.


