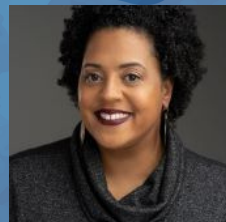

What Qualifies a Member for Board Leadership?

As we embark on this new Rotary year with a new Board of Directors, we thought it would be helpful to explain how Eligibility for Leadership works.

To be a nominee for Board Leadership in our club, a member has to have met the following criteria:

1. Must have been a member for the last 3 consecutive years
2. Must have led a committee or major project
3. Must be a contributor to our foundation
4. Must be a member in good standing—attendance at 60% or better and dues are paid.

In order to be qualified for President, they have to meet the criteria above AND have served at least one year as a Board Director.
