Throughout the months of August, September, and October, our Service Committees vetted grant applications from 38 non-profit organizations. Thank you to those who spent time working on these initial reviews, site visits, and presenting at Foundation Advisory Committee! As of Monday, October 16th, the Club Board and the Foundation Trustees have approved the FAC recommendations for funding 14 of these grants, in the amount of \$118,180. We are beginning to let these organizations know of their determinations. The 2nd Cycle grant application deadline is October 31st. 



MEMBERSHIP TRENDS - WE ARE GROWING!


OVERALL MEMBERSHIP HAS INCREASED 22% SINCE COVID!

REPRESENTATION ACROSS AGE GROUPS!




MEMBERSHIP BY YEARS OF SERVICE. 35% OF OUR MEMBERS HAVE JOINED SINCE COVID.
