Judge Connelly is responsible for establishing the Veterans Treatment Court at the Toledo Municipal Court. The VTC was designed to match veterans with professional services, such as mental health treatment, substance abuse counseling or help with a job search through Veterans Affairs (VA).

He is a graduate of the Ohio State University and the University Toledo College of Law. While in law school, he was employed as an intern with Eastman and Smith, Ltd. Upon graduation, he was an associate with Kerger and Kerger; Bill was in private practice from 2002 to 2005 until he was hired as an assistant prosecutor in Wood County, Ohio from 2005 until 2009.

Bill is the father of Karis age fifteen and William age thirteen.
