The National Museum of the Great Lakes & Toledo: A Vision of Tomorrow

The Great Lakes represent 84% of the North American continent's freshwater....and there is a different story in every drop! The National Museum of the Great Lakes opened its doors in Toledo, Ohio in 2014 to share those stories, and since that time this institution's growth has been extraordinary. Their first decade in Toledo allowed them to establish themselves as a top destination by opening the current 11,000-square-foot facility, restoring a 617-foot lake freighter and tug boat museum vessels, and connecting it all through their Maritime Park. The second wave of growth, breaking ground in April of this year, will elevate the museum to a new vision that will both support its mission AND support Toledo. Rotary Member and new Executive Director Kate Fineske will join us to share her vision as well as highlight the local community and economic impact of this incredible resource that began a new era of opportunity on the East Bank of Toledo's Maumee River.

Kate Fineske is the Executive Director of the Great Lakes Historical Society and its National Museum of the Great Lakes. She has an undergraduate degree from the University of Toledo and a Masters of Business Administration with a emphasis on non-profit business from Lourdes University. Kate joined the museum's team in 2019, and quickly became a key member of the organization's leadership—helping guide the mission forward through a period of unprecedented growth and change. In January 2024, she became the museum's Executive Director, responsible for overseeing all aspects of the organization's operations and furthering its new vision to become the place where all Great Lakes conversations happen. With over 20 years of experience in nonprofit leadership, communications, and education, Kate is passionate about history, a strong advocate for arts and culture, and has served and supported numerous community boards including currently serving on the School Board for The Maritime Academy of Toledo.




