Service Above Self Day - In Lieu of Luncheon

We are excited for Monday's Service Above Self Day in lieu of our normal luncheon. Thank you to all of our committee chairs who have planned wonderful opportunities for our members to participate in! We have four volunteer experiences that you can sign up for here: <u>Service Above Self Day</u>

1) Vocational and Disability Services collaboration:

• Traumatic Brain Injury Resource Center (TBIRC). From 12 pm - 2 pm. Receive a short tour of the TBIRC facility. Participate in some of the same therapeutic activities that brain injury survivors and volunteers do in their work there: creating fleece blankets, packing condiment bags for their disease-specific food pantry and a few other station activities that assist in the operation of the organization. Be treated to a high-protein lunch as both a treat and an educational piece that demonstrates the importance of nutrition in brain injury recovery.

2) International Committee:

• Supply Collection to benefit Toledo Helps Ukraine from 12:00-1:00 pm. Set up at the Target on Monroe Street, to raise awareness and collect supplies for THU. The following items will be collected for a shipment to Ukraine in September: power and hand tools, tarps, work gloves, work boots, batteries, flashlights, canned goods, nonperishable foods.
