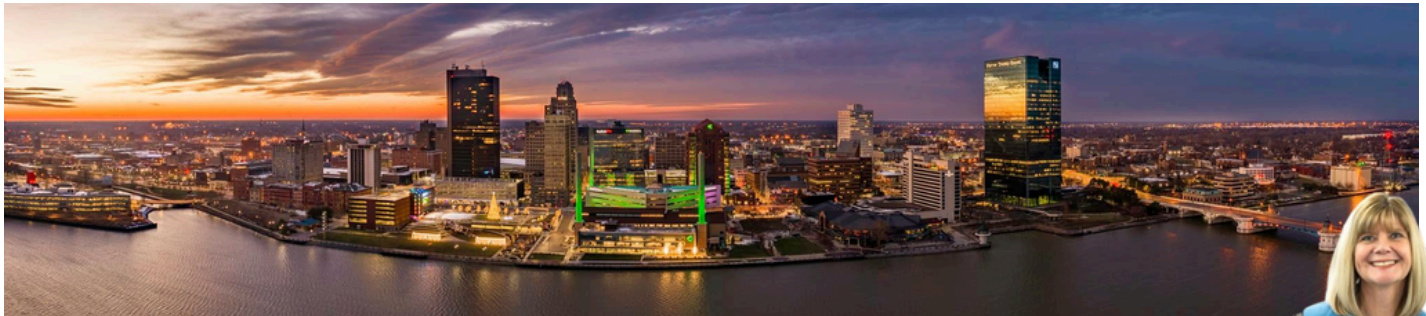

As TARTA’s Chief Executive Officer, Laura Koprowski brings 25 years of diverse transit transportation experience to the role at the state and local levels. She most recently served as part of the leadership team that has transformed TARTA in just under 2 years.

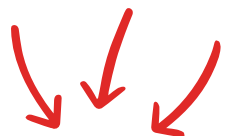
Koprowski joined TARTA and returned to her hometown of Toledo in April 2020. She previously served as the Executive Director of the Ohio Public Transit Association. During Koprowski’s tenure as the Vice President of Government Affairs and Communications at the Central Ohio Regional Transit Authority, the organization was nationally recognized in 2018 as the outstanding mid-size public transit system by the American Public Transportation Association. She worked on a variety of projects including implementing COTA’s transit system redesign, serving as a liaison to Smart Columbus to create technology mobility solutions, and serving on the development and launch team for microtransit with COTA Plus.
