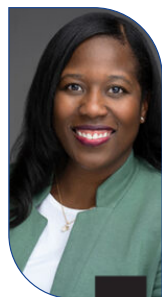

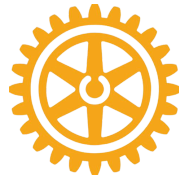

JACK ROGERS

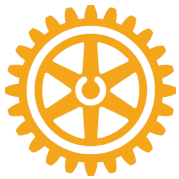
1926-2026


